Subject: Planned release of brood year 2017 into the Sacramento River at Elk Horn Boat Launch Facility.

On May 2, 2018, the Department of Fish and Wildlife will release approximately 1,000,000 brood year 2017 fall run Chinook salmon from Feather River Hatchery into the Sacramento River at Elk Horn Boat Launch Facility. This release will include 25% marked (adipose fin clip) and Coded Wire Tagged (CWT) fish (Table 1). For questions concerning this release, please contact Jay Rowan (916) 358-2883.
