Subject: Planned release of brood year 2017 Chinook salmon fall run into the San Pablo Bay.

On May 18th 2017, the Department of Fish and Wildlife will release approximately 730,000 brood year 2017 fall run Chinook salmon from Feather River Hatchery, and on May 19th 2017, approximately 300,000 fall run Chinook salmon from the Feather River Hatchery Annex, into San Pablo Bay. This release will include 25% marked (adipose fin clip) and Coded Wire Tagged (CWT) fish (Table 1). For questions concerning this release, please contact Jay Rowan (916) 358-2883.
